We will aim to send a text by 9am if the event is cancelled due to bad weather as we don't want any injuries incurred on slippery, wet grass.

PE Kits: Children are to arrive at school already in PE kit, black shorts, white t-shirts and trainers (no plimsolls). Learners will remain in PE kit for the whole school day. Please provide their BFS Hoodie for them to wear and possibly a coat depending on the weather. Of course, if it is sunny please apply sun cream before you get to school and provide a sun hat. Please ensure everything is labelled. **Please tie long hair back and ensure earrings are covered and watches and jewellery are removed.**
